Cru (our parent organization) has annual Winter Conferences around the different regions. San Diego hosted the Pacific Southwest region. So two other AIA staff and I were able to go out there for a few days to see who the Lord might be calling to AIA staff. Our efforts were centered on a recruiting dinner for those interested. We had around 30 students attend as we shared how God called us to ministry and specifically AIA. It was really amazing that the three of us each had very different stories. In the end, many students were interested, but most of them were only freshmen and sophomores. My desire for instant results left me a bit discouraged, but my boss reminded me that this is a good initial touch point for the younger classes.

In January I went to an AIA Winter Retreat in North Carolina to recruit. This was a little more fruitful in terms of possible near future staff because (1) all the students attending already knew about AIA and (2) there were more upper classmen. We'll see what the Lord does! Aside from recruiting, God was definitely moving at this retreat! We broke out into men's and women's groups. I led a group of four men through the topics of manhood and sexuality. My exhortation to them was dig deep and grow in God's definition of what it means to be a man. I believe these are crucial times for Christians to understand and defend our beliefs on man- and womanhood.
